The Conrad Code of Conduct applies to each and every student; however, individual circumstances involving an identified **special need** will be considered when applying consequences of the school code of conduct.

School District 52 and Conrad Elementary School will take all reasonable steps to prevent **retaliation** against a student who has made a complaint of a breach of this Code of Conduct (ie. getting back at someone).

The Golden Rule:

Treat others the way you want to be treated.

To promote the values expressed in the BC Human Rights Code, I will respect the rights of all individuals and accept differences. A person will not be discriminated against, denied accommodation, service or facility customarily available to the public because of race, colour, ancestry, place of origin, religion, marital status, family status, physical or mental disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, or age of that person or class of persons.

Conrad Elementary School Behaviour Code

I am responsible for my own behaviour at all times: no excuses.

The **purpose** of this behaviour code is to establish and maintain a safe, caring, orderly and healthy environment for a purposeful and positive learning and teaching climate. It is also to clarify and publish expectations for student behaviour while at school, going to and from school, and attending any school function or activity at any location.

Acceptable Conduct and Expectations:

- I respect myself, others and the school.
- I am committed, to learning, attending school regularly and am on time each day.
- I come to school ready to work.
- I am considerate to all students.
- I will be helpful and friendly to all students and adults.
- I will act in a safe and responsible way.
- I will be polite and use proper manners when speaking to others.
- I will tell the truth and respect other people's things.
- I will walk in an orderly manner in the building at all times.
- I will wear my indoor shoes in the building.

Notification:

Parents of offenders and offended will be notified of all major offences.

General School Rules:

- I will respect and follow the directions of all adults.
- I will get into line as quickly as possible after the bell has rung.
- I will keep all areas clean.
- I will report any bullying or safety concerns to an adult.
- I will not climb fences, rock walls, trees, goal posts & basketball hoops.
- I will only play in designated areas.
- I will bounce or kick balls in designated areas only.
- Helmets will be worn when riding a bike/skateboard/scooter. I will walk beside these items when on school property.
- During winter months, I will not throw snowballs or slide on ice.
- I will use technology in a safe and appropriate manner.

Unacceptable Conduct:

Behaviours that:

- interfere with the learning of others
- interfere with an orderly environment
- create unsafe conditions

Acts of:

- bullying: physical, emotional, and technological
- name-calling, foul language (offensive writing on clothing)
- physical violence (ie. fighting, throwing objects etc.)
- vandalism or theft
- retaliation (ie. "getting back at someone")
- use of dangerous items

The above behaviours are examples and are not all-inclusive.

Consequences:

The Conrad discipline cycle will be used for all offences. Students, where possible, will participate in the development of meaningful consequences.
